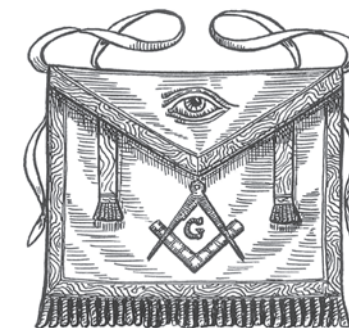

FROM THE EAST

A MASTER'S MESSAGE



his Trestleboard marks my last month as Master of Los Angeles Lodge No. 42. My wife and I will be moving "Deep in the Heart of Texas" to the little town of Brownwood. I have been a California Mason for forty-two years. During that time I have been privileged to have known thousands of good men whom would have otherwise remained at a perpetual distance.

This fraternity has honored me in many ways. I have been given the privilege of serving as an officer twenty for of those years and as Lodge Master a total of six times and in three different Lodges. I was on four different Grand Lodge committees, served as Web Master for the Grand Lodge web site for seven years, and am currently serving as Web Master for the site that hosts, at no charge, any California Masonic Lodge website. Ocean Park Lodge honored me with the Hiram Award. In 1986, I wrote a very simple computer application named "Lodgeical" for the then Secretary of my Lodge. It gained a certain following and was eventually adopted by our Grand Lodge as the application they recommended for the management of the Secretary's office. It is now the official application in seven Grand Jurisdictions and is used in a generic form in every jurisdiction in the United States.

I mention the above not to brag about my accomplishments, but to make a point. None of this would have happened to me without my membership in this great fraternity. As was mentioned above, the men that have crossed and influenced my life over the last four decades have turned me into a far better person than I could have done on my own.

My entry into Masonry was as a thirty-something young man. I was lucky enough to have a large group of 'older' members who took me under their wing, so

to say. They guided me during those early years. After forty-two years, I am still being taught lessons by the members of this fraternity. But things have changed. Now at seventy-three there are fewer members who are 'older'. So, my education now comes from the younger members of our fraternity.

I leave California with only a hint of sorrow—I will no longer to be an active member of this Lodge. Other than that, there are no regrets. And I will leave with the knowledge that our Lodge is in good hands. The new leadership consists of young, energetic visionaries who are inspired with the thinking of a new generation of Masons. These men are the future, not only of this Lodge and our fraternity, but our Nation as well.

As I look back on this year, it is with some regrets and some degree of pride. I wish we had been able to raise more Master Masons. However, we did some things this year of which we all can take pride. We are now 'Los Angeles Lodge No. 42'. Our name has been restored, and we have a new beginning with new leadership for the future. You, the members of this Lodge, should come out and participate in your new revitalized Lodge. I am most proud of this Lodge for doing what is at the heart of the meaning of Masonry. We honored in a very real way the tenets of Masonry. No greater opportunity could come before a Lodge. You did yourself proud.

So I make my farewells with the melancholy of not being able to participate with you as you move into the future of the Lodge—but with the happiness of knowing it will flourish and grow and be a force in the community for good. Thank you all for allowing me to serve as your Master this year. May God bless you and Los Angeles Lodge.

RESOLUTION TO AMEND BYLAWS

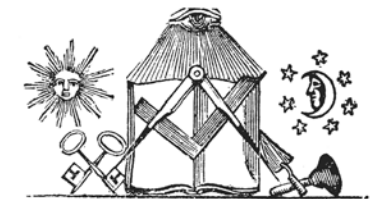
WHEREAS the Grand Lodge Per Capita increases every year, and;
